Consultation phase for proposed framework for the VA and VASP regulation gets underway

The National Anti-Money Laundering and Countering the Financing of Terrorism Committee (NAC) has today launched the consultation phase for the proposed framework for the regulation of Virtual Assets (VA) and Virtual Asset Service Providers (VASP).

The framework has been developed with a view to encouraging innovation and supporting the growth of the VA industry in a responsible and sustainable manner, whilst also importantly addressing and safeguarding against the potential financial crime risks associated with the misuse of VA products and VASP services offered in or from the Seychelles.

The NAC has been actively engaged in an action plan to address such risks and the requirements of the Financial Action Task Force (FATF) Recommendation 15 which relates to new technologies. The NAC intends to submit a request for re-rating for Recommendation 15 by March 2024 for consideration by the Eastern and Southern African Anti-Money Laundering and Countering the Financing of Terrorism (ESAAMLG) Task Force in September 2024. The consultation phase being launched today is a key component of this action plan.
