Q2 Issuance Plan of Government Securities

The Government of Seychelles acting via the Ministry of Finance, National Planning and Trade intends to sell Treasury Bills (T-Bills) and Treasury Bonds (T-Bonds) according to the following indicative Issuance Calendar for the second quarter (April 1, 2022 to June 30, 2022). This will enable institutional and retail investors to plan their investments efficiently and provide transparency and stability to the Government securities market. The issuance calendar for T-Bills is as per table below.

Bond Particulars

- ✓ The coupon rates will be announced closer to the auction date.
- ✓ Three tenors, 3-years, 5-years, 7-years, are being proposed for the T-Bonds.
- ✓ One tenor, 5-years for the DBS Bond.
- ✓ All Bonds will be available on auction basis, the allocation of which will take place one week after the application window opens and will close at 8.30 am on the auction date.
- ✓ The Bonds will be issued in multiples of SCR 1,000 with a minimum value of SCR 1,000.
- ✓ The auction will be both on a competitive and non-competitive basis, with the former limited to depository institutions and other financial institutions² and the latter available to all other eligible investors. The issuance of the Bonds is applicable to both residents and non-residents having a Seychelles rupee account with a local financial institution, in all cases.
