VACANCY

The Government of Seychelles invites applications from suitably qualified and experienced professionals for the position of Director at the Financial Intelligence Unit (FIU).

Duties and Responsibilities

- The Director shall be responsible for managing the affairs of the FIU and shall be responsible to administer the powers and functions of the FIU under section 13 of the Anti-Money Laundering and Countering the Financing of Terrorism (AML/CFT) act.
- The Director shall in the discharge of his or her duties, exercise the powers to develop and maintain a disciplined, efficient and performance driven administration in the FIU.
- The Director shall perform the functions of the office within the strategic framework determined by the Minister on the basis of the recommendations of the National AML/CFT Committee.
- The Director may assign specific responsibilities to the Deputy Director.
- The Director shall periodically evaluate the performance of the officers of the FIU and document the outcome of such evaluation.

Competencies and Attributes

- High level of integrity, confidentiality and professionalism
- Strong analytical and decision-making skills
- Excellent leadership and stakeholder management capabilities
- Sound knowledge of financial crime risks and AML/CFT regulatory frameworks
- Ability to operate in a high-pressure and sensitive environment
- Strong communication and reporting skills

Minimum entry requirements in accordance with section 14 of the AML/CFT act.

- Is a Seychellois;
- Holds a degree in law, economics, finance or any discipline from an institution recognised by the Seychelles Qualifications Authority;
- Has at least seven years of work experience in the relevant field of his or her educational qualifications; and
- Has such other qualifications or requirements.

Terms of the Appointment

- Appointment will be made in accordance with the AML/CFT Act and relevant Government procedures; and
- Attractive remuneration package commensurate with qualifications and experience
