National Grants awards SCR 5,898,434 towards seventeen (17) projects

Established in 2019, the National Grants Funding Scheme is a financing scheme for Registered, not-for-profit civil society organisations through the Social Program of Central Government in the Annual National Budget (Appropriation Bill).

Under the first Call for Proposals for the 2026 Grant Cycle, the sum of SCR 5,898,434.00 has been awarded towards seventeen (17) projects geared towards the country's National Development Strategy (2024–2028), thus contributing to the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and Agenda 2063. To date, a total of 154 projects, worth SCR 49,960,440.80 has been financed under the National Grants Funding Scheme.
