



NATIONAL GRANTS FUNDING SCHEME

The National Grants Committee (NGC) has awarded an additional SCR 443,258.00 towards two (2) projects following its second Call for Proposal, launched on 1st April, 2026. This makes it a total of nineteen (19) projects altogether under the 2026 grant cycle with a grand total amount of SR 6,341,692.00

The purpose of this funding scheme is to support a diverse portfolio of projects geared towards the country's National Development Strategy (2024–2028), thus contributing to the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and Agenda 2063.

Since its establishment in 2019, a total of **156 projects** worth **SCR 50,403,698.80** have been funded under the National Grants Funding Scheme.
